Wolfram discussed progress of 2012 awareness programs with increased health fair support and added speaker engagement. Also discussed was the Prostate Cancer Symposium as a function of increased awareness.

Events for 2012 and anticipated events for 2013 were reviewed including the "Hawgs of Texas" Bike Rally in Columbus, TX in April, 2013.

There were four Screening Events in 2012.

The Education and Awareness brochures were discussed and the need to place more of them in doctor's offices for increased awareness.

The "Let's Talk on Tuesday" discussion group continues to be available and the Long Term Survivor list has been increasingly engaged on the NTxPCC website.

According to Gayle Wilkins, the STEPs to Surviving Prostate Cancer is planned to discontinue due to drop in enrollment

The 2012 Prostate Cancer Symposium was attended by approximately 80 people.

Gayle Wilkins is searching for speakers for the 2012 Symposium from a list of potential speakers. The Symposium will be held at Noah's on Saturday, April 20, 2012.
