



Financial Statement Cash Flow





NTxPCC History


- Started with a website for a local Support Group in Fort Worth, 2008

 Medical City Dallas, Mid-Cities
- Formed a Coalition, Spring 2009
- Elected Directors & Officers, Fall 2009
- Applied for Non-Profit Status for Texas approved 2009
- Applied for 501 (c)(3) status with IRS approved Feb. 2010
- Exempt from Franchise Taxes
- Expanded to include Tyler PCAP, June 2010
- Expanded to include 50 Hoops, Dallas, December 2011
- Tyler now Affiliate Member, 2012
- Expanded to include Man-to-Man UT-Southwestern, 2012








Survivor Chat
