



Board of Directors Proposed Special Committee



The Board of Directors shall appoint an Internal Audit Committee. The Internal Audit Committee will consist of three members, with preferably at least one member coming from outside the Board. Neither the Treasurer nor the President can serve on this Committee.

The purpose of The Internal Audit Committee is to meet with the Treasurer to independently examine, verify and provide written confirmation of the validity of the financial transactions and treasury procedures. Examination shall include verifying transactions against bank records and confirming both, documentation and traceability. At the direction of the Board of Directors, the Committee will meet periodically, but at least yearly. The written report(s) of the periodic audits will be provided to the Board of Directors in a timely manner and a synopsis provided for the Yearly Financial report. Copies of the written report(s) will be included in the records of the Coalition.




North Texas Prostate Cancer Coalition Actual 2017 - Budget & Actual 2018
