We are providing information on prostate cancer and on important cancer-related local events. We offer working group meetings where survivors gather to share information and experience in areas of concern common to the group.

Sharing information and experience with other survivors can provide increased knowledge and capability to work with your doctor to assure effective decision making.

In addition to Coalition programs, local support groups offer monthly meetings for men with prostate cancer and partners involved in their support. Presentations by expert medical professionals and staff followed by discussion periods are essential to understanding the physical and emotional effects of the disease and to promote the healing process.
